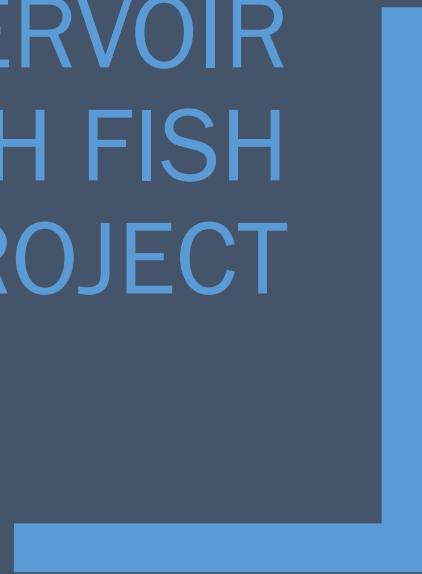

THE NORTH Poudre IRRIGATION COMPANY.

Greeley, Colo., AUG. 8, 1901.

Pursuant to call the persons named as the directors in the certificate of incorporation of The North Poudre Irrigation Company, filed in the proper offices on the first day of August, 1901, met at the office of James W. McCreery, Esq., in the city of Greeley, Colorado, for organization and for the transaction of affairs pursuant to the powers contained in the certificate of incorporation.

Directors present: Burton D. Sanborn, H.C. Andrews, George M. Houston, Edwin S. Pinney, and Raymond F. Walter.

Absent: None.

On motion of B.D. Sanborn the directors proceeded to the organization of the board.

On motion of director Houston, B.D. Sanborn was elected president of the board.

On motion of director Walter, George M. Houston was elected secretary of the board.

On motion of director Pinney, Charles H. Wheeler, cashier of the Greeley National Bank was elected treasurer of the company.

On motion the president and secretary were directed to issue one share of the capital stock of the company to each of the persons named as directors in consideration of services rendered by them, and each of them, up to this date, in the promotion and organization of the corporation.

The secretary presented the following preamble and resolutions:

"Whereas our said company has been organized to acquire the canals, reservoirs and lands, situate in Larimer county, in the state of Colorado, heretofore owned and operated by The North Poudre Land, Canal and Reservoir Company, and to acquire other property, and for other purposes; and

"Whereas the board has now been advised that Thomas Bradley of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, who is now in possession and control of the said property, offers to sell and convey all of said property, both real and personal, free and clear of all incumbrances, in consideration
