





Upper Colorado River Compact, 1948


- % Apportionments to CO, NM, UT, WY &50k maf/yr to AZ

- Established Upper Colorado River Commission




State Apportionments




Hoover Dam and Glen Canyon Dam




In 2022 Arizona, Nevada and Mexico saw cuts to water deliveries by 613,000 acre-feet
